

## **Volunteer Opportunities**

### **Local Caseworker**

#### **Overview**

Services to the Armed Forces and Veterans caseworkers assist the local chapter with providing emergency communications between families and those serving in the military. Caseworkers assist with the data management of each service member's case, provide referrals and resources, and assist as able with special outreach projects.

#### **SAF Caseworker Requirements**

Completion of casework training. Current online and instructor lead courses are under redevelopment. Volunteers must be able to provide a 6 month commitment that involves being on call 3-4 times a month. On call periods are 12 hours each. Caseworkers must have basic computer skills and reliable online connection.

### **Service to the Armed Forces Reserve Corps**

#### **Overview**

Service to the Armed Forces (SAF) reservists are employed on short-term assignments around the world. Primarily, they are assigned as a deployment team member to support the United States Armed Forces in conflict areas. Occasionally, assignments are available at overseas U.S. military installations outside of the conflict area and at domestic military installations.

Reservists assist in the delivery of American Red Cross services to members of the U.S. military and their families assigned to military installations worldwide. They provide high-quality service to customers and clients, consistent with SAF and Red Cross standards. Reservists provide supervision to volunteers and non-exempt employees, when applicable. They represent the organization within the military command and adhere to military regulations and authority. Reservists must work effectively with employees and volunteers at chapters, service areas, blood services regions and national headquarters.

#### **SAF Reserve Requirements**

Requirements to serve as an SAF reserve include the ability to obtain a security clearance, strong computer skills, and meeting certain health requirements for those interested in a deployment assignment. Familiarity with Clarify software is desired.
